Alumni Clinic (All day June 5, 6 & 7)

Limited to those who have previously ridden with Joe, this is an opportunity for riders to step up their game a bit, progress even more and just have a good time in the company of fellow alumni. The first day will be devoted to advancing horsemanship skills and geared to the specific goals of each horse/rider. The next two days will also include cow work to help further develop the horse/rider connection, and of course have some fun while we're at it. Participants may bring more than one horse and switch off throughout the clinic. We will send out a questionnaire prior to the clinic asking riders to set goals and provide Joe with information to help him address each rider's individual needs. We will accept a maximum of 10 riders. Cost is \$950 per rider.

Colt Starting (Late afternoon June 5, 6 & 7)

This class is for horses that haven't yet been ridden or may have been ridden, but are still very green or have some problems that might be helped by restarting with a different approach. Riders must have previously ridden with Joe or be preapproved by Joe and the clinic sponsor. Class is limited to 4 colts. Cost is \$600 per horse.

Pre-registration and 50% deposit are required to reserve your spot.

Spectators Welcome

The audit fee for spectators is \$30 per person, per day (pay at the gate). There is no audit fee for 4H/FFA youths, rider spouses, or for parents of minor children riding in the clinic.

Facility Fees

There is a \$100 facility charge for each rider, which includes horse pens. Please bring your own water buckets, feed and hay. Riders are responsible for cleaning their pens and picking up after their horses. Wheelbarrows will be provided.

Accommodations

Dry camping and trailer parking available at the arena with showers and restrooms nearby. Limited electrical plug-ins by reservation only. (Contact Patti)
