**Cancellation policy:** Payments are non-refundable unless clinic is cancelled.

**Additional Fees:** A facility charge of \$100 per rider includes indoor and outdoor arenas, horse pens and camping. Please bring your own water buckets and feed. Riders are responsible for cleaning their pens and picking up after their horses. Cattle fee will be determined just prior to the clinic. Both the facility and cattle fees are due at start of clinic and should be made payable to Patti Hudson.
